

RESIDENTIAL PERMIT

(Under Para 7 of the Foreigners Order, 1948)

Serial No.

1. Mr/Mrs/Miss a foreigner ofnationality holding passport No: dated valid tillissued at for India is permitted to remain in India until.....

2. This permit must be surrendered at the time of departure from India to the Registration Officer of place from which Mr/Mrs/Miss leaves India.

3. In the event of Mr/Mrs/Miss/..... not parting from India before he/she/ will unless he/she obtained the permission of the Central Government to remain for a long period , be liable to prosecution for a contravention of the provision the Foreigners Act 1946, punishable with imprisonment for a period of 5 years with fine and will also be liable to expulsion from India.

4. Application for an extension of the period of this permit must made at least ninety days before and must be addressed to the Government of India through the State Government . Government has discretion to withhold any application which does not disclose adequate grounds of an extension.

This permit will be cancelled as and when the holder is found POSITIVE FOR AIDS.
